

Dr. James “Jim” Fleming

Dr. Fleming is a preeminent scholar of Biblical archaeology, history and interpretation. He is unsurpassed in his unique ability to illustrate and make the Biblical text come alive.



His teaching skills and techniques astound and inspire his audiences around the world, weaving together four perspectives for a better understanding of Biblical times: theology, archaeology, history and geography. He uses an ecumenical approach to bring together old and recent discoveries to assist us in our faith journey.

Having studied in the United States and Israel, Dr. Fleming earned his Doctor of Education from Southwestern Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas. Dr. Fleming is an adjunct member for a number of accredited graduate schools, sending students to study in Israel.

For much of the time from 1974-2001, Jim Fleming lived and worked in Israel, and developed courses of study in historical geography and Biblical history.

Dr. Fleming served as Director and Academic Dean for the Jerusalem Center for Biblical Studies from 1980 to 1987. He also worked with the Israel Ministry of Tourism to teach Jewish and Arab guides about important sites of the New Testament and Byzantine periods of history.

He is the Founder and Director of the *Explorations in Antiquity Center* located in LaGrange, Georgia. This contains full scale replicas of life in Biblical times. He has also founded the *Biblical Resources Study Center* in Jerusalem.

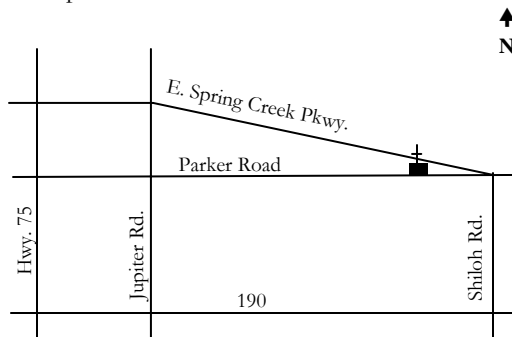


First United Methodist Church Plano is over 160 years old, with the first church service held in a log cabin near our present location. The church has been at its present site for more than seven years.
