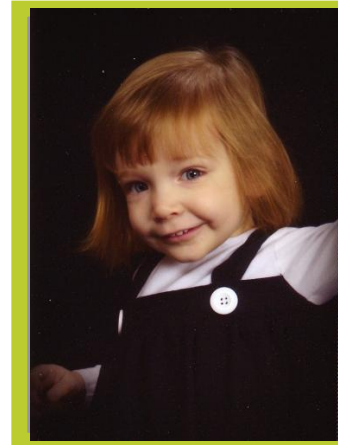

Hayden is a young girl with a huge battle and as MPKids we are going to help Hayden and her family through this rough time.

Your mission is to create a banner and "boredom" baskets for Hayden, her mom, and brother. On this banner, we will put loving words and sign our name so we can remind Hayden and her family that we are thinking about and care about them. We will create a basket for Hayden, Cameron, and Peri. Hayden loves Dora the Explorer; Cameron enjoys building things and Star Wars, while Peri just needs things to occupy her time while at the hospital. There are plenty of things we can put into these baskets, coloring books, puzzles, games, and books are all really good ideas of things that Hayden and Cameron can do while at the hospital.
